

FTO Checker

Unilateral Confidentiality Commitment

This document outlines FTO Checker's commitment to treating all user-submitted invention descriptions, and the personal data of users, with strict confidentiality.

1. All invention descriptions submitted through FTO Checker are treated as confidential.
2. For search purposes, FTO Checker uses secure transformations of the submitted invention (not the original text) to query patent databases.
3. FTO Checker does not retain submitted invention descriptions after processing is complete.
4. No invention data or user email addresses are disclosed to third parties, under any circumstance.
5. FTO Checker will not attempt to reproduce, reverse-engineer, or derive any commercial benefit from the invention descriptions submitted by users.
6. This is a unilateral commitment. No signature is required from the user, and no reciprocal confidentiality obligations are imposed.

This policy applies automatically to all submissions received via FTO Checker.

This commitment is governed by Swiss law. The competent jurisdiction is Lausanne, Switzerland.
